Administrator of PA services	Municipalities and Cooperatives
Funder of service	The municipalities receive funds from the state. Afterwards the municipalities decide the size of the contribution to the citizen in need of Personal Assistance.
Disabilities covered	People with intellectual and physical disabilities
Possible amount of hours per day/week of PA	Depends on the municipality
Assessment of needs: tool and how often	Assessment is carried out within the frame of the legislation. It is up to the municipalities to interpret the laws in their assessments.
Hourly rate funded	Depends on the municipalities
Age	18-65
Number of users in the country	About 2500
