

Introduction

This briefing aims to provide evidence of how the European Union (EU) funds – specifically the <u>European Regional Development Fund</u> (ERDF) and the <u>European Social Fund</u> + (ESF+) – are used by the EU Member States to support the process of deinstitutionalization (also referred to as the 'transition from institutional to community-based care' by the European Commission).

The EU Cohesion Funds, including ERDF and ESF+, aim to promote economic and social cohesion between the Member States, and to support them in creating a more inclusive and fair Europe. However, instead of advancing the right to independent living and the inclusion of disabled people in the community, ENIL's findings reveal that many EU-funded projects perpetuate the segregation of disabled people in institutions and other segregating settings.

ERDF and ESF+ are being used to discriminate against disabled people, violating fundamental rights enshrined in international and European legal frameworks. EU funds have an obligation to comply with legal requirements, particularly the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union (EU Charter) and the United Nations Disabilities (CRPD). Yet, many projects continue to promote institutionalisation of disabled people, including through segregated housing and education. These institutions are not limited to the traditional large-scale facilities, but also include small group homes, day care centres, and other residential care settings that isolate disabled people from the rest of the community.

Such violations contravene the EU Charter and other international human rights instruments, such as the CRPD. Instead of developing solutions that enable independent living in the community, such as introducing personal assistance and increasing the stock of accessible non-segregated housing – as required by Article 19 of the UN CRPD and further defined by General Comment No. 5 and the Global guidelines on deinstitutionalization, including in Emergencies – EU funds are being misused to create, maintain or expand institutions, contributing to the segregation of disabled people and children. Instead of genuine deinstitutionalization, in line with the CRPD, they lead to transinstitutionalisation of disabled people.

Methodology

This section aims to provide a clear understanding of the methodology employed to collect and analyze data, ensuring the reliability of the findings.

ENIL conducted comprehensive data collection from June until August 2024 to establish the number and scope of EU funded projects with the objective of supporting deinstitutionalization.

Due to the number of Member States in receipt of EU funds for the projects affecting disabled people and the lack of capacity to undertake field research in all the countries, ENIL used the official European Commission platform known as Kohesio to collect evidence.

According to the website, which is managed by DG for Regional and Urban Policy, "Kohesio is a comprehensive knowledge database that offers easy and transparent access to up-to-date information on projects and beneficiaries co-funded by EU Cohesion policy, during the 2014 – 2020 programming period." It adds that the

database will be progressively updated with new projects and beneficiaries for the 2021 – 2027 programming period, in close cooperation with the EU Member States and programme authorities.

The main aim of the mapping exercise was to identify the establishment of new institutions or the renovation of existing segregating facilities and services across the EU. At the same time, we searched for projects which may be considered as examples of good practice – where the funds were channeled into community-based services which support the right to independent living.

How we searched for the relevant projects

A uniform methodology was used by researchers, to ensure consistency of the data collected. Under the 'Projects' section, different keywords for each EU Member States were combined, such as "deinstitutionalisation" and "personal assistance" in relation to 'persons with disabilities', while also using advanced filters to specify the funding sources, respectively ERDF and ESF (a predecessor of the European Social Fund+). It is worth noting that the search covered related terms, which did not need to be specified separately.

ERDF and ESF were selected as funds most likely to be used to support projects relevant to persons with disabilities, specifically social care infrastructure and support services.

The screening of the large number of results involved a careful review of relevant projects from multiple sources. When the information on Kohesio was unclear or insufficiently detailed, research was undertaken into funding beneficiaries for further insight. Often, this involved going through websites in different EU languages.

How the information was recorded

Several key details were recorded in an Excel table, including:

- Country
- Type of EU fund used
- Amount of EU contribution allocated to the project
- Project name
- Additional information, such as the number of disabled people impacted, the total number of beneficiaries, further details about the project, sources, implementation period, and direct links to the project pages.

The Excel table (with rough data) is available in the Annex to this briefing.

Limitations

Despite the comprehensive approach adopted by researchers, several limitations were encountered. These included.

Insufficient project information: Kohesio often provides limited details on individual projects, making it difficult to obtain an in-depth understanding of each one. Researchers relied on their expertise on services for disabled people to establish which project is relevant and whether it supports Independent Living. Further information was sought, as mentioned above, by searching through websites of beneficiarities.

- Inconsistency of data: The discrepancies between information on Kohesio and the official webpages of projects – particularly regarding terminology, beneficiary numbers, and project dates – led to confusion about the scale and impact of the projects.
- Lack of official sources: A lack of reference to an official source was observed on Kohesio. In some instances, relevant sources were unavailable, with no dedicated webpages for the beneficiary or the projects, and limited information beyond what was available on Kohesio, representing a significant obstacle in verifying data.
- **Translation and linguistic barriers:** Considering that automatic translation is used to translate information from the managing authorities into data on Kohesion, some of the language was difficult to understand. This was further complicated the by having to translate information from the beneficiaries' websites from different EU languages once again, using automatic translation.
- **Absence of projects from the current programming period:** All projects identified are from the 2014-2020 period, although this was not the initial intention of the research. Indeed, no projects from the 2021-2027 period were found on Kohesio.

Due to these limitations, the analysis of several projects had to be excluded from the findings. It is essential to consider these factors when reflecting on the final count of EU funded institutions for disabled people.

The limitations presented are also indicative of general barriers to monitoring EU funds. Project information, whether presented by the European Commission or the Managing Authorities, is insufficient to understand how the investments affect the lives of the final beneficiaries (in this case, disabled people).

Definition of deinstitutionalisation

A key reason for this exercise was the concern that projects intended to support deinstitutionalization of disabled people were in fact perpetuating segregation, leading to transinstitutionalisation and failing to achieve the right to independent living.

The reasons for this are multifold – from the lack of support for the right to independent living, in line with Article 19 of the UN CRPD, the lack of vision, the absence of adequate deinstitutionalization strategies, the competing interests between service providers (institutions), in some cases families of disabled people and disabled people advocating for independent living, and others. Hijacking of the independent living concepts and terminology is also very common, whereby the language of inclusion and human rights is used to justify segregation.

To understand how deinstitutionalization should be implemented, we must rely on the UN CRPD and the related documents – the General Comment 5 and the Guidelines on deinstitutionalization, including in Emergencies. Recommendations by the Committee on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities to the EU and Member States are also key to understanding what deinstitutionalization should look like.

According to the <u>Guidelines on deinstitutionalisation</u>, including in <u>Emergencies</u> (paragraphs 19 and 20):

"Deinstitutionalization comprises interconnected processes that should focus on restoring autonomy, choice and control to persons with disabilities as to how, where and with whom they decide to live.

Processes of deinstitutionalization should be led by persons with disabilities, including those affected by institutionalization, and not by those involved in managing or perpetuating institutions. Practices that violate article 19 of the Convention should be avoided, such as renovating settings, adding more beds, replacing large institutions with smaller ones, renaming institutions, or applying standards such as the principle of the least restrictive alternative in mental health legislation." (emphasis added)

With regard to children with disabilities, the Guidelines advise as follows (paragraph 43):

"For children with disabilities, deinstitutionalization should be directed towards protection of the right to family life, in accordance with their best interests. For children, at the core of the right to be included in the community is the right to grow up in a family. An "institution", in the context of children, is any placement that is not family-based. Large or small group homes are especially dangerous for children. International standards that justify or encourage the maintenance of residential care are inconsistent with the Convention and should be updated." (emphasis added)

In relation to older persons with disabilities, deinstitutionalisation encompasses the following processes (paragraph 52 of the Guidelines):

"All deinstitutionalization efforts should include older persons with disabilities, including those with dementia who are placed in institutions or are at risk of institutionalization. **Deinstitutionalization should target both disability-specific and other institutional settings for older persons, including "dementia villages".** States parties should prevent discrimination against older persons with disabilities in terms of access to support and services in the community and their own homes. "(emphasis added)

The Guidelines also explain what support services – specialised or mainstream – are needed to ensure that disabled people can leave institutions and to prevent institutionalisation. Additional services are needed to support people who have been institutionalised for longer periods of time to move back into the community and to live independently.

The Guidelines note that the following residential services, as defined in Article 19, should be available to disabled people (paragraph 33):

"The term "residential services refers to community-based support services aimed at ensuring equality and non-discrimination in the exercise by persons with disabilities of their right to adequate housing. Examples of residential

services are social housing, self-managed co-housing, free matching services, and assistance in challenging housing discrimination."

Definition of an institution

When claiming that a certain investment amounts to institutionalization, this document relies on the definition of an institution set out in the General Comment 5. According to this definition, "although institutionalized settings can differ in size, name and set-up, there are certain defining elements, such as:

- obligatory sharing of assistants with others and no or limited influence over whom one has to accept assistance from;
- isolation and segregation from independent life within the community;
- lack of control over day-to-day decisions;
- lack of choice over whom to live with; rigidity of routine irrespective of personal will and preferences;
- identical activities in the same place for a group of persons under a certain authority; a paternalistic approach in service provision;
- supervision of living arrangements;
- and usually also a disproportion in the number of persons with disabilities living in the same environment.

Large or small group homes are especially dangerous for children, for whom there is no substitute for the need to grow up with a family. "Family-like" institutions are still institutions and are no substitute for care by a family;

Overview of the data analysed

As described above, the Kohesio website was used to identify projects funded by ERDF and ESF with the objective of supporting deinstitutionalization of disabled people. Below is the overview of the data that was analysed.

Main concerns about the use of ERDF and ESF for deinstitutionalisation

Based on the analysis of 287 projects, worth 234,4 million EUR, from 11 countries, we have identified the following investments which do not comply with Article 19 of the CRPD – the right to live independently and being included in the community. This

is because they contact at least one element from the definition of an institution or otherwise limit disabled people's full participation in society:

- Investments in group homes
- Investments in large institutions
- Investments in day-care centres
- Investments in group homes and larger institutions for children and older people

Leading in total funding, €80.4 million were invested in Poland's segregating projects, particularly in settings for older people. These projects target people facing poverty and social exclusion. In total, the 115 projects in Poland targeted around 7,264 disabled individuals.

Investments in group homes and family type homes

The majority of funding is allocated to the development of group homes or family-type homes, perpetuating the segregation of disabled adults and children. This is particularly true for countries such as **Romania** and **Latvia**. For instance, **Romania** allocated €19.6 million for similar projects, targeting at least 683 disabled beneficiaries.

Investments in large institutions

Significant investments are still being directed towards large scale institutions in countries such as **Bulgaria**, **Poland**, **Latvia**, **Hungary** and **Romania**.

Investments in day-care centers

Based on our analysis, day-care centers are a popular focus for investments. While day-care centres are not always a concern, they should be inclusive of all – not just disabled children or adults – and should not replace opportunities for education or employment of disabled people. Day-care centres that deny disabled people opportunities for social inclusion in local schools, clubs, sports and leisure activities, lead to or reinforce social exclusion.

It is of special concern when day care centres are combined with segregated housing (group homes), because this further reduces opportunities of disabled people to be included in their local community on an equal basis with others.

Latvia invested €70.8 million in projects such as day care centers, group apartment services, and specialized workshops, targeting 2,474 disabled individuals. **Poland** and **Romania** are the other two countries in which these investments were most common.

Out of the projects identified as including day-care services, **there were 79 under ERDF and 83 under ESF**. In some cases, day-care services were attached to group homes, but in the majority of cases, the day-care centers were separate. In several cases, it was not possible to identify the nature of day-care centers with the information available, to assess whether or not they provide community-based services or, instead, are segregated settings for disabled people, replacing the opportunities for education, employment or participation in the life of the community.

A total of **42** projects identified as day-care centers targeted children, with 33 under ERDF and 9 under ESF. These day-care centers were segregated by disability, only including services for children with disabilities and not for all children. Other groups that were often targeted are older persons and persons with psychosocial or intellectual disabilities.

Investments in group homes and larger institutions for children and older persons

Many of the projects identified in our research targeted children and older persons. They involved construction, renovation or the running of different facilities. A **total of 68 projects under ERDF and 36 under ESF partially or totally targeted children**; they included day care centres, respite care, family-type homes. **47 projects under ESF targeted older people**, the vast majority being day-care services, but also some small group homes; and 6 under ERDF, with a mix of larger institutions, small group homes, and day-care services.

Investments in community-based services with a potential to support independent living

The analysis also revealed that the ESF has funded projects introducing home care services, telecare, and health services, or community mental health centres.

We identified under ESF 2 projects on telecare, 7 on home care, 2 community mental health centres for adults and 2 community mental health centres for children, and 2 projects including provision of psycho-social-legal counseling services. Furthermore, there were 21 social rehabilitation centres for children under ERDF and 4 under ESF; and 9 ESF projects including rehabilitation services for adults, although mostly in day-care centers, plus 1 under ERDF. A total of 4 projects under ESF included the development of individualised assessment plans. We found that many of the services listed here are part of larger projects in which segregated services are also financed.

An example of a good practice would be the "<u>Development of Social Service Infrastructure for the Implementation of the Deinstitutionalisation Plan in Kandavas Municipality</u>", where they planned to restore the physiotherapy office to provide services to children with disabilities.

There is a limited amount of projects supporting access to personal assistance and community-based services. Although we are aware through our members that personal assistance pilot projects have been implemented at least in <u>Greece</u>, <u>Portugal</u> and <u>Croatia</u>, we did not find any information on these on the Kohesio website. We did not find any cases in which Centers for Independent Living are being financed by the ESF or ERDF, aside from the Portugal personal assistance scheme (in which the centers are not directly managing the funds).

Provision of healthcare and rehabilitation services are pillars of independent living, and it is positive that these are receiving EU funding. However, it is necessary to reinforce the other pillars, financing personal assistance, advocacy, or assistive technology.

Conclusion

Projects are wrongly labelled as deinstitutionalisation

The CRPD Committee <u>Guidelines on deinstitutionalization</u>, including in emergencies (2022) define deinstitutionalization as processes that restore disabled people's autonomy, choice and control over how, where and with whom they decide to live.

In so far as EU funds are channelled to projects that put disabled people in a restrictive living environment – where housing and support are provided as part of the same package - they are contributing to discrimination and segregation.

There is a widespread misconception about what constitutes an 'institution'. While many investments are channeled into smaller group homes or family-type homes, these settings tend to replicate institutional practices rather than supporting the right to live independently within the community. However, when such investments were found, they were often labelled as contributing to deinstitutionalisation and community living.

The findings highlight a misuse of the term 'deinstitutionalization', with funding being directed to projects that continue to segregate rather than facilitate social inclusion and participation. Such investments contravene the rights of disabled people enshrined in the UN CRPD.

The EU is still investing in segregation

The EU's contribution to the projects reveals a significant ongoing financial investment in projects that continue to support the segregation of disabled people. The total EU funding in institutions amounts to over €236 million - split between the ERDF and the ESF - covering the period 2014-2020. This funding primarily benefits countries like Poland, Romania, Latvia, Bulgaria, and Croatia, with Poland, Latvia and Croatia receiving the most substantial allocations of the funding analysed. The total number of disabled people targeted by the projects is about 2,781 across various countries.

Monitoring investments is extremely difficult

The development of a platform such as Kohesio is extremely useful, as it allows EU citizens and the civil society an insight into how EU funds are spent, without having to search to hundreds of websites in different EU languages. However, a platform like this is only as good as the information provided by the managing authorities. It is clear, from the work undertaken by ENIL, that the information available does not provide a complete picture of projects that are being funded. The most recent information, from the current programming period (2021 – 2027) is not available at all and project

information is often too scarce to confidently establish what the project is about – specifically, how the final beneficiaries (in this case, disabled people) will benefit from the investment provided and whether their human rights will be respected.

Recommendations

ENIL calls on the European Commission and the managing authorities to:

- Integrate the Guidelines on deinstitutionalisation, including in Emergencies into EU Cohesion policy, and consistently apply them in different stages of EU Funds spending.
- Provide guidance to Member States to promote deinstitutionalization and independent living, in line with UNCRPD Guidelines on deinstitutionalization, including in Emergencies.
- Enforce safeguards to end investments into institutions, ensuring compliance with the UNCRPD and the EU Charter on Fundamental Rights, and support national deinstitutionalization strategies which are aligned with the UNCRPD and the Guidelines on deinstitutionalization, including in Emergencies.
- Take action to prevent investments into institutions and segregating settings.
 This includes avoiding the use of ERDF and ESF+ for "transinstitutionalisation", or the transfer from big institutions into smaller ones.
- When unplanned investments into segregated settings occur, use the available tools to withdraw EU funding and, where necessary, launch the infringement procedure.
- Improve transparency and disaggregated data collection on institutions for disabled people, children and adults across the EU, using the definition of an institution from the UNCRPD and the General Comment 5.
- Closely monitor investments that lack sufficient safeguards, and hold Member States accountable to their commitments under the Operational Programmes, where they commit to deinstitutionalization and alignment with the UNCRPD.
- Together with disabled people and their representative organisations, identify independent living practices that may be replicated in other Member States and promote them at EU level. Support the development and implementation of deinstitutionalisation strategies, including through the use of EU funds.
- Ensure the participation of a diversity of Disabled People's Organisations (DPOs) - including consulting survivors of institutionalization - at all stages of planning, implementation and monitoring of EU funds and deinstitutionalization initiatives.
- Increasingly expand investments into community-based services and support for disabled people, including personal assistance, and the work of DPOs, Centers for Independent Living and Personal Assistance Cooperatives.
